Technical Community Update

- Release update
 - Euphrates
 - The release has been delayed 2 weeks due to:
 - Major holiday in China during the first week of October
 - Access to lab resources
 - Lack of quality builds/test results
 - Consensus that additional two weeks will improve the release readiness/quality
 - New technical release date: October 20th
 - Marketing release in the morning of October 24th CET for announcement at the Open Source Summit-Prague
 - TSC also discussed doing a single "dot release" for Euphrates scheduled for mid-December
 - This is to avoid impacting the Fraser release schedule
 - 2018 releases
 - Release names selected for 2018: Fraser and Gambia
 - The TSC approved the Fraser [timeline](#) with a target release date in April'2018
