### [Release milestones \(M1\) - Release planning - Walter Kozlowski, Gergely Csatri](#)

- RM is not aligned to any other projects being external or internal
- RA-s should specify by the M1 milestone which RM version they "implement" in the actual release
  - It is possible to "implement" the same version of RM what is developed in the same release cycle or part of it

- In case of partial implementation the implemented and not implemented requirements must be traceable back to RM
- RI-s should specify by the M1 milestone which RA version they implement in the actual release
  - It is possible to select only particular features from the RA
  - In case of partial implementation the implemented and not implemented requirements must be traceable back to RA
- RC-s should specify by the M1 milestone which RA version they implement in the actual release
  - It is possible to select only particular features from the RA
  - In case of partial implementation the implemented and not implemented requirements must be traceable back to RA
- Definition of version of open source components (even major ones, like OpenStack or Kubernetes) should happen during the release in the scope of RA projects in agreement with their dependent projects
- Open issues
  - We should decide if we would like to define absolute or relative versions of the open source components
